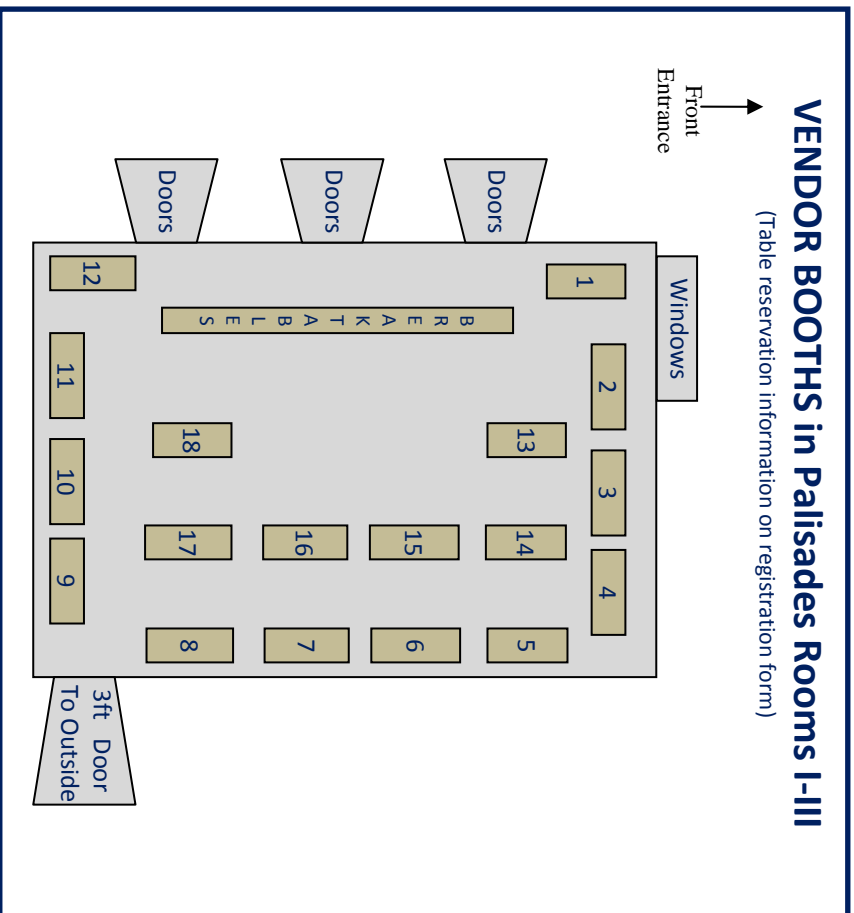

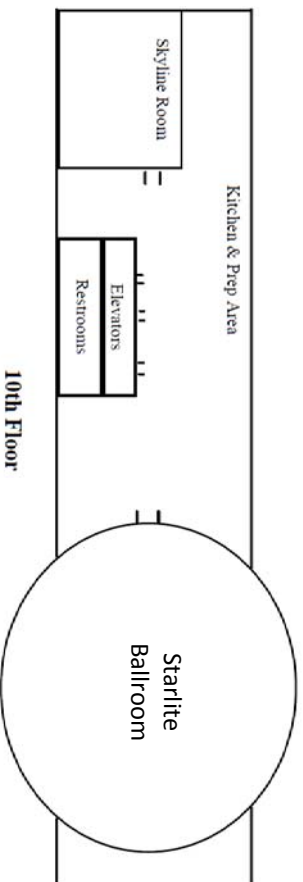
VENDOR BOOTHS in Palisades Rooms I-III
