SDES is teaming with the Empire Mall to kick off E-Week on Saturday, February 19<sup>th</sup> with a Mini Golf Course Challenge to benefit Habitat for Humanity. Include Team Name, Sponsor (if any), Team Captain with contact information, and a list of your Team Members in the email.

Each Team will construct an engineering themed mini golf hole which you will transport to the mall on the morning of the 19<sup>th</sup>. Each hole will be judged on a

variety of criteria including but not limited to engineering theme, portability, incorporation of recycled materials, safety, and creativity. Official rules and further details will be distributed to registered teams. The top three holes will be announced at the Awards Banquet on the following Saturday. Registrations are being accepted now, and will close at the end of Monday, January 24<sup>th</sup>. Our goal is to have 8-10 mini golf hole entries to kickstart engineering discussions and awareness among mall patrons. There is no entry fee, however, event sponsor-



ships are being sought to cover event costs and kickstart the Habitat for Humanity donation bucket.


