Whereas, South Dakota's economy has grown, in part, because the hard work and success of licensed professional engineers; and,

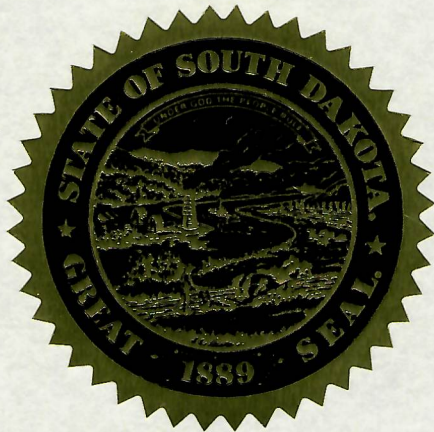
